NOTICE OF NOMINATION

For the office of one(1) councillor

ELIGIBILITY:

1. Every member of the Chipewyan Prairie First Nation, who is eighteen years of age, is eligible to vote in that election.

NOMINATIONS:

2. Any Candidate for Chief or Councillor must be a band member who is eligible to vote in the election.
3. A Candidate for the position of Chief or Councillor must be nominated by five members who are eligible to vote in that election.
4. The nomination by the five band members of a candidate should be made by them in person at the nomination meeting.
5. A candidate must consent to the nomination and may do so in person, or in writing at the meeting.
6. A candidate who consented to the nomination may withdraw by doing so in writing at least twenty-four hours before voting begins.

Disqualification from Office:

1. Any person who is convicted of an indictable offence is disqualified from holding the office of Chief or Councillor for a period of six years from the date of conviction.
2. **VERY IMPORTANT** – C.P.I.C criminal record check document is required at the nomination meeting. R.C.M.P. require two weeks to complete security record check.
