WHEREAS: a quorum of the Council of the Chipewyan Prairie First Nation (the "First Nation") met on the 30 day of March, 2022;

AND WHEREAS: Pursuant to the powers granted to the Council under the *Indian Act* and the First Nation's inherent rights of self-governance, the Council is empowered to make decisions on behalf of the Nation and its Members;

AND WHEREAS: The 2022 general election for the positions of Chief and one Councillor has been scheduled for April 6, 2022 (the "Election") with polling stations located in Fort McMurray, Edmonton and Chard Alberta;

AND WHEREAS: A significant percentage of the First Nation's voters reside in La Loche, Saskatchewan;

AND WHEREAS: The La Loche Winter Trail closed on March 18, 2021 for the season due to warm weather conditions which will make it difficult for voters residing in La Loche to access a polling station;

AND WHEREAS: The First Nation wishes to accommodate voters residing in La Loche by holding an additional polling station located in La Loche, Saskatchewan;

AND WHEREAS: The polling stations located in Fort McMurray, Edmonton, and Chard Alberta will be open from 10:00am to 7:00pm and Council wishes for all polling stations to be open for the same period of time.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:
