NOTICE OF NOMINATION MEETING:

Notice is hereby given to the Electors of the Chipewyan Prairie First Nation that the nomination meeting for the offices of: Chief and (1) Councillor will be held on **March 23, 2022** at the Janvier Multiplex, Nokohoo Rd., Chard, AB, T0P 1G0 from **12:00pm to 8:00pm**.

Completed nomination forms must be provided to the Electoral Officer in person by **8:00pm** on the date of the nomination meeting. The nomination form is attached to this notice.

Any five electors may nominate a person to be a candidate for Chief or Councillor in writing or in person at the nomination meeting.

In order to become a candidate, the person nominated must consent to their nomination in writing or in person at the nomination meeting.

All nominations must be delivered in person to the Electoral Officer at the nomination meeting by (a) one of the five electors nominating the candidate or (b) the candidate being nominated.

Please note: All candidates must provide the Electoral Officer with a Canadian Police Information Centre (CPIC) report **at least 24 hours** before the voting begins on election day and will be disqualified if they fail to do so.
